Subject: Call for Proposals for the Undergraduate Research Associates Program

Each year hundreds of faculty members from across the University act as mentors for undergraduates engaged in original research. Funding for undergraduate research stipends is available from a number of different sources at the school and university levels.

I am writing to invite you to submit a proposal to the Undergraduate Research Associates Program (URAP), administered by the Office of the Provost. Last year 73 faculty proposals received URAP funding to support undergraduates working in a broad range of disciplines. The current call for proposals covers funding for the period **Summer 2011 through Spring 2012**.

Standard student stipends are \$3000 for the summer, and \$1000 or \$1500 for an academic semester. An individual proposal may request up to \$10,000, including an allowance of 10% for materials and supplies. Program details and proposal requirements are available on-line at

The deadline for receipt of proposals at the Office of Undergraduate Programs is Tuesday, **February 22, 2011**.

Undergraduate stipends are also funded through two fellowship programs that require student-authored applications and brief faculty recommendations. The Rose Hills Foundation Undergraduate Research Fellowship Program provides summer funding for residents of Southern California with majors in science and engineering. The USC Provost's Undergraduate Research Fellowship Program provides summer and academic-semester funding for undergraduates working in all disciplines.
